



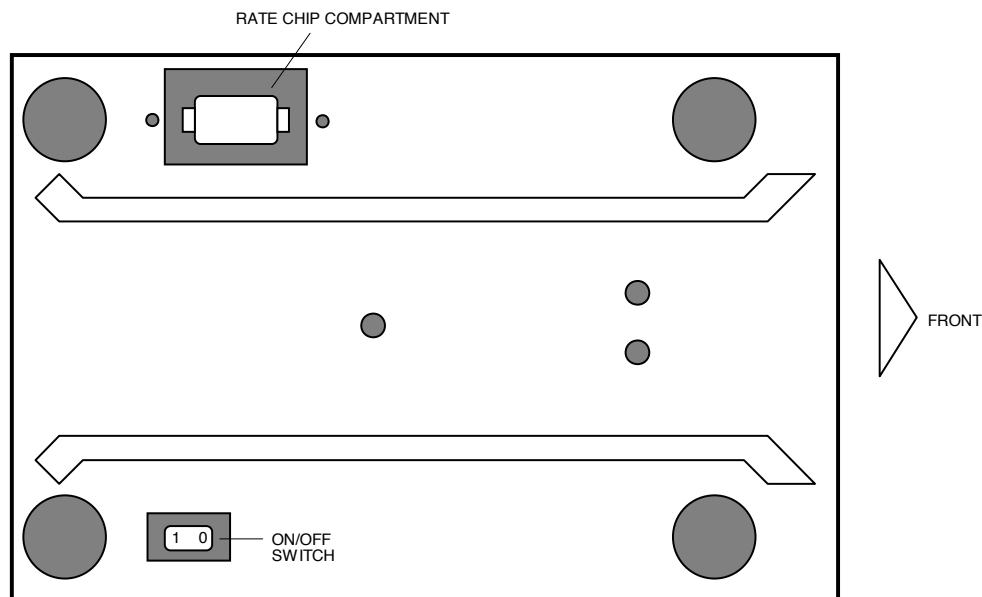

INSTRUCTIONS FOR INSTALLING A RATE CHIP FOR SPS-30 Rate Computing Scale

1. Turn the scale off and unplug the AC adapter from the wall outlet. If the scale is connected to a remote device, unplug that connection also.
2. Remove the top platform and set aside.
3. Gently turn the scale on its left side, and locate the area of the rate chip compartment, which is covered by a small plate (see drawing below).
4. Remove the rate chip compartment cover by removing the screws.
5. Remove the old rate chip. There are tabs on both ends to assist removal.

You may use your fingers to pry the rate chip out, or *gently* pry out using the flat blade of a screwdriver.

6. Install the new rate chip. Push gently until it is seated completely into its socket. The socket will allow installation in only one direction.
7. Reinstall the rate chip compartment cover, return scale to its upright position and replace the platform.
8. Re-connect the adapter and remote device, if applicable.
9. Your scale is now ready for use with its new, updated rates.

RELEASE NOTES FOR VERSION 6.0

All rates and fees have been updated for the May 31, 2015 pricing change.

NOTE: There is only one version of the update this year:

- First Class Mail Letters – Stamps

USPS Domestic Mail:

- All rates and fees are compliant with the May 31, 2015 pricing change.

NOTE: Zone 9 is still not supported

USPS International Mail:

- All rates and fees are compliant with the May 31, 2015 pricing change.

NOTE: As before, only Groups 1-3 are supported for FCMI and FCPIS

UPS (Daily Rates):

- All rates and fees are compliant with the December 29, 2014 pricing change.

Zone Charts:

- All USPS zone charts are compliant with the June 01, 2015 release.
