
## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR INSTALLING A RATE CHIP FOR**

# **SPS-30 Plus Rate Computing Scale**

- 1. Turn the scale off and unplug the AC adapter from the wall outlet. If the scale is connected to a remote device, unplug that connection also.
- 2. Remove the top platform and set aside.
- Gently turn the scale on its left side, and locate the area of the rate chip compartment, which is covered by a small plate (see drawing below).
- 4. Remove the rate chip compartment cover by removing the screws.
- 5. Remove the old rate chip. There are tabs on both ends to assist removal.

You may use you fingers to pry the rate chip out, or *gently* pry out using the flat blade of a screwdriver.

- 6. Install the new rate chip. Push gently until it is seated completely into its socket. The socket will allow installation in only one direction.
- 7. Reinstall the rate chip compartment cover, return scale to its upright position and replace the platform.
- 8. Re-connect the adapter and remote device, if applicable.
- 9. Your scale is now ready for use with its new, updated rates.

#### USPS Domestic Mail:

- All rates and fees are compliant with the May 31, 2015 pricing change
- Zone 9 (Freely Associated States) still not supported

#### **USPS International Mail:**

- All rates and fees are compliant with the May 31, 2015 pricing change
- PMI <sup>1</sup>shipments to Canada now require a zone (1-8)
- PMI weight limit to Netherlands (Rate Group 17) has increased to 66 pounds
- PMEI<sup>2</sup> service is established to Burma (Myanmar), Kiribati, and Sao Tome and Principe
- St. Christopher has been renamed to Saint Kitts and Nevis
- Western Samoa has been renamed to Samoa

• All rates and fees are compliant with the December 29, 2014 pricing change.

#### FedEx Express (Standard List):

• All rates and fees are compliant with the January 5, 2015 pricing change.
