



INSTRUCTIONS FOR INSTALLING A RATE CARD FOR

SPS-70DL Rate Computing Scale

- 1. Turn the scale off and unplug the AC adapter from the back of the scale.
- 2. Locate the rate card cover (a small plastic door) located towards the front of the scale, on the right hand side (see drawing below).
- Remove the rate card cover. If necessary, use the flat blade of a screwdriver to gently pry off from the top.
- Use your fingers to remove the old rate card. Use a back and forth motion to release the rate card from its socket.
- Install the new rate card label side UP - into the scale. Using a back and forth motion, push the rate card until it fits snugly into its socket. The socket will allow installation in only one direction.

- 6. Test the rate card installation by reconnecting the AC adapter and switching the scale on. If the scale does not power up, the rate card may not be completely seated into its socket. Repeat step #5 until the scale works properly again.
- 7. Replace the rate card cover. If necessary, loosen two of the housing screws on the bottom of the scale to accomplish this.
- 8. When the scale prompts you to install the new rates, press the ENTER key and allow time for the new rates to load into memory.
- 9. Your scale is ready for use with its new, updated rates.
